H 1020. SAFETY PROFESSIONALS. TO PROVIDE TITLE PROTECTION FOR THE SAFETY PROFESSION. Enacts new GS 90-646 to define a Safety Professional (SP) as a person who through studies and training is competent to identify, control, and prevent various hazards. Further defines Associate Safety Professional (ASP), Board of Certified Safety Professionals (BCSP), and Certified Safety Professional (CSP). Enacts new GS 90-647 to prohibit a person from engaging in the practice of safety as a safety professional without completing the training and studies required by GS 90-646(5). Exempts from the act a supervised student, a person licensed by a state board or commission, and a person who does not use the title SP, ASP, or CSP.
