H 105. BUTNER COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE. TO CREATE THE BUTNER ADVISORY COUNCIL AND TO ENUMERATE ITS DUTIES. Adds new part 1B to Art. 6 of GS Ch. 122C as title indicates. Council will have seven members elected in nonpartisan at-large elections. Council members will serve four-year staggered terms. Jurisdiction will be treated as city for purpose of applying election laws, filling vacancies, and organization and procedures of council. Council may advise Sec'y of Health and Human Services in exercise of powers granted by GS 122C-403 to govern Butner. Secretary must either adopt or disapprove council's recommendations within 30 days. Adds GS 122C-411.1 to allow public safety fees assessed in Butner territorial jurisdiction to be placed in special fund to be used to fund Butner Public Safety Division in Dep't of Crime Control. Continues Study Comm'n on Transfer of Butner Public Safety through Dec. 31, 2000. Intro. by Crawford.
