H 1094. YOUTH EMPLOYEE/ABC PERMITEES. TO ALLOW TEENAGERS WHO ARE FIFTEEN YEARS OLD TO WORK AT CERTAIN PLACES THAT SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. Adds new GS 95-25.5 to allow 15 year old to be employed by person holding alcohol beverage control permit for on-premises consumption if parent or guardian has authorized employment in writing, day after work is not school day for the youth, youth does not prepare, serve or sell beverage, and work site is restaurant, hotel, sports club, or private club with 18 hole golf course. Busing tables is not considered to be possession of alcohol. If parent withdraws permission, employer must terminate the employment relationship.
