H 143. HANDICAPPED PARKING FINES. TO INCREASE THE FINE FOR UNLAWFUL PARKING IN HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES. Amends GS 20-37.6(f) to make violation of GS 20-37.6(e)(1), (2) or (3) (parking in space designated for handicapped persons without authorized use of designated plate or placard; or obstructing a curb ramp or curb cut for handicapped persons) subject to \$500 fine (now, no less than \$50, but no more than \$100). Effective Dec. 1, 1999.

H 143. HANDICAPPED PARKING FINES. Intro. 2/25/99. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes penalty for violation of GS 20-37.6(e)(4) [improper use of handicapped parking signs] from \$50 to \$100. Amends GS 20-37.6(d) to provide that parking spaces for handicapped persons on streets and public vehicular areas shall be designated by free-standing signs, no less than 72 inches from the ground or, signs, placed at the same height, attached to a building.

H 143. HANDICAPPED PARKING FINES. Intro. 2/25/1999. House amendments make the following changes to 2nd edition. Allow sign designating handicapped parking space to be attached to building or fence or other structure. Changes penalty for violation of GS 20-37.6(e)(1), (2), or (3) to at least \$100 but not more than \$250 (formerly, \$500).
