H 1566. TEMP. MV LIEN FILING. *TO PROVIDE FOR A PROCEDURE FOR CREATION OF A TEMPORARY LIEN ON A MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN A MANUFACTURER'S STATEMENT OF ORIGIN OR AN EXISTING CERTIFICATE OF TITLE ON A MOTOR VEHICLE IS UNAVAILABLE.*

Amends GS 20-58 as title indicates, permitting first lienholder to file notarized copy of instrument creating and evidencing security interest in motor vehicle with Division of Motor Vehicles.

Declares such a filing is constructive notice of security interest to all persons, and provides for effective date of such notice and for expiration of notice. Permits Division to charge a fee up to \$10 for each notation filed pursuant to act. Effective Dec. 1, 2000.

H 1566. TEMP. MV LIEN FILING. Intro. 5/16/00. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Adds new GS 20-52.1(d) to provide that when a manufacturer's statement of origin or an existing certificate of title on a motor vehicle is unavailable, a motor vehicle dealer licensed under art. 12, Ch. 20, may also transfer title to another by certifying in writing to the DMV that all prior perfected liens on the vehicle have been paid and that the motor vehicle dealer, despite having used reasonable diligence, is unable to obtain the vehicle's statement of origin or certificate of title. Makes a conforming amendment to GS 20-72(b). Adds a provision to GS 20-79.1(h) that upon expiration of 30 days from date of issuance, a second 30-day temporary registration plate or marker may be issued by the dealer upon showing the vehicle has been sold, a temporary lien has been filed as provided in GS 20-58, and that the dealer, having used reasonable diligence, is unable to obtain the vehicle's statement of origin or certificate of title so that the lien may be perfected. Changes effective date from Dec. 1, 2000, to May 1, 2001.

H 1566. TEMP. MV LIEN FILING. Intro. 5/17/00. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. This bill amends GS 20-52.1 and -72(b) to add a provision for transfer of title for a motor vehicle when the manufacturer's statement of origin or an existing certificate of title is unavailable, though a certificate in writing by motor vehicle dealer to the Division of Motor Vehicles. This committee substitute adds a requirement that the certification be sworn.

H 1566. TEMP. MV LIEN FILING. Intro. 05/17/00. House amendment makes the following changes to 3rd edition. Makes false filing of sworn certifications authorized by act Class H felonies.

H 1566. TEMP. MV LIEN FILING. Intro. 5/17/00. Senate committee substitute, as amended, changes 4th edition to (1) require DMV to credit to the Highway Fund any fees charged to motor vehicle dealers who file with DMV an instrument creating security interest under GS 20-58(b), and (2) provide that a dealer who transfers title pursuant to certification under GS 20-52.1(d) shall hold harmless the purchaser from any damages arising from using this transfer procedure.
