Leaves in bill the provision that Orange County may regulate and prohibit the open burning of trees, limbs, stumps, and construction debris as a condition for the approval of a permit for subdivision, clearing, and development of land, or construction of buildings, but (1) deletes general provision that the county may by ordinance regulate and prohibit such burning and (2) adds a provision specifying that the regulation on burning may not apply to agricultural, horticultural, and silvacultural activities which are exempt by law from requirements for county permits.
