H 1769. STANLY LEGAL ADVERTISING. TO REDEFINE THE NEWSPAPERS ELIGIBLE TO ACCEPT LEGAL ADVERTISING IN STANLY COUNTY. Amends GS 1-597 to provide that in the event the newspaper otherwise meeting the qualifications and having the characteristics prescribed by GS 1-597 to GS 1-599, is admitted to the United States mails as third class matter rather than periodicals class matter, the newspaper shall qualify if it maintains a known office in the county or political subdivision where such publication, advertisement, or notice is required to be published, is originated and published for the purpose of disseminating information if a public character, is not primarily designed for advertising purposes, and does not contain more than 75% advertising in more than one-fourth of the issues published during the preceding six-month period.
