Makes new title "AN ACT ALLOWING THE DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN ISLE BEACH, THE CITY OF KINSTON, AND LENOIR COUNTY BY PRIVATE SALE." Add provision to permit Lenoir County and the City of Kinston to acquire, sell or lease real property needed to provide relocation housing for flood victims of Hurricanes Fran and Floyd. Exempts those localities from the limitations on the use and disposal of property provided in Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes or the Charter for the City of Kinston.
