Requires the employee holding the certificate to enroll in an approved program leading to a masters degree in school administration before the provisional certificate expires. Amends GS 115C-289(b) to provide that holders of a provisional assistant principal's certificate shall be employed under GS 115C-287.1(h), a newly-enacted section that provides a local board may enter into 1-year contracts with an administrator who holds a provisional assistant principal's certificate. If the administrator held career status as a teacher in the local school administrative unit prior to being employed as an assistant principal and the State Board for any reason does not extend the school administrator's provisional assistant principal's certificate, the administrator shall retain career status as a teacher unless the administrator voluntarily relinquished that right or is dismissed or demoted under GS 115C-325.
