Adds provision authorizing Dare County Comm'rs to create one or more utility districts for purpose of raising and expending funds to install underground utility lines in the district or districts. Sets out procedure to establish district, to include notice and public hearing. Allows municipality to include itself in a single district with permission of county board and after notice and hearing. Specifies membership rules, and allows county board to levy tax up to \$1 per month for residential customers and \$5 per month for commercial customers. Specifies procedure for administration of tax.
