H 651. BRUNSWICK FIRE FEES. TO ALLOW BRUNSWICK COUNTY TO ASSESS A FIRE PROTECTION FEE. Authorizes Brunswick County to create a fee-supported fire district for insurance grading purposes if it receives (1) written request signed by at least two-thirds of members of board of directors of a fire department that contracts with the county to provide fire protection in the county, or (2) a petition signed by 15% of the resident freeholders living in an area in the county, describing the area to be designated as a district. Specifies provisions for responding to request or petition, establishment of committee for a district, fees, and extension or abolition of a district.
