H 845. GREENVILLE UTILITIES COMMISSION. Intro. 4/1/99. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Makes bill's provisions applicable to City of Greenville and Greenville Utilities Comm'n (was, comm'n only) and (1) provides that the authority to operate steam and chilled water systems applies only if the system is located in the Greenville Industrial Park and is entirely within the corporate limits of the city or its extraterritorial jurisdiction, (2) provides that the authority to operate a public enterprise applies only if approved by the governing body of the entity and the enterprise is located within Pitt County, (3) deletes the bill's grant of authority to operate appliance warranty programs, security monitoring systems, and surge protector programs for customers of the utilities comm'n, and (4) adds a provision authorizing the city and the comm'n to charge appropriate fees for any expanded services offered pursuant to this bill. Changes title to "AN ACT EXPANDING THE PERMISSIBLE PURPOSES OF THE GREENVILLE UTILITIES COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSION TO CHARGE APPROPRIATE FEES FOR EXPANDED SERVICES."
