H 854. PITT 1% SALES TAX/CAPITAL. TO AUTHORIZE PITT COUNTY TO LEVY A ONE-CENT LOCAL SALES TAX FOR COUNTY AND MUNICIPALITY CAPITAL OUTLAY AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS, IF APPROVED BY THE VOTERS OF THE COUNTY. Authorizes Pitt County to levy a 1% local sales and use tax in addition to the current 2% local sales and use tax, to be used only for county and municipal capital outlay and infrastructure improvements and to retire indebtedness for these purposes, if approved by a referendum of the voters. Tax does not apply to non-prepared food.
