H 863. ST. JAMES INCORPORATION. TO INCORPORATE THE TOWN OF ST. JAMES. New town is located in Brunswick County. Town will have a governing board of five members (mayor will be chosen by the governing board from among its members), elected at-large in nonpartisan elections to two-year terms. Town will operate on the council-manager plan. Citizens and property are to be subject to municipal taxes levied for the year beginning July 1, 1999. Names individuals to sit on initial governing board and to serve until successors are elected in November 1999. Provides that town may not, before Dec. 31, 2009, adopt any ordinance creating a planning agency, regulating or restricting the subdivision, zoning, or use of any land, or providing for building inspections.
