H 94. SUPERIOR COURT DIVISION ELECTIONS. TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF NORTH CAROLINA TO ALLOW ELECTION OF SUPERIOR COURT BY DIVISION, AND TO IMPLEMENT THAT AMENDMENT. Amends Article IV of NC Constitution to allow General Assembly to use judicial divisions as unit of election for superior court (now, may use district or state); prohibits Chief Justice from assigning regular judges of superior court outside of division, unless it is emergency; and requires General Assembly to divide state into at least eight divisions. Sets amendment for November 2, 1999 general election. If amendment passes, amends GS 7A-41.2 to establish division as unit of election for superior court, for both nomination and election. Amends GS 7A-41(a) to divide state into eight divisions, as follows: 1A—Districts 1,2, 3A, 6A, 6B, 7A, 7C; 1B—Districts 3B, 4A, 4B, 5, 8A, 8B; 2A—9, 9A, 10A-D, 14A, 14B, 15A, 15B; 2B—11A, 11B, 12A-C, 13, 16A, 16B; 3A—District 17A, 17B, 21A-D, 22, 23; 3B—District 18A-E, 19A, 19B, 19C, 20A, 20B; 4A—District 24, 25A, 25B, 28, 29, 30A, 30B; 4B—District 26A-C, 27A, 27B. Makes conforming changes to GS Ch. 163. Election law changes effective with 2000 general elections; new division lines become effective January 1, 2001.
