H 978. DAMAGED PIERS IN STATE PARKS. TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO PERMIT ANY OWNER OF PRIVATE PROPERTY ON A LAKE LOCATED IN A STATE PARK TO RESTORE THE PROPERTY OWNER'S PIER TO THE CONDITION THAT THE PIER WAS IN IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE TIME OF THE DAMAGE WHEN THE DAMAGE IS CAUSED BY A NATURAL DISASTER.

Adds new GS 113-42.1 as title indicates. Allows person who owns pier subject to act who was denied a permit to restore the pier on or after Jan. 1, 1996 to reapply.

H 978. DAMAGED PIERS/BOAT STALLS/WHITE LAKE. Intro. 4/12/99. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition: (1) rewrites title to AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE OWNER OF A PRIVATE OR JOINT PRIVATE PIER AT WHITE LAKE STATE LAKE THAT WAS DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF A NATURAL DISASTER TO REBUILD ITS PIER TO ITS CONDITION IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DAMAGE, TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL BOAT STALLS ON A PIER AT WHITE LAKE STATE LAKE UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, AND TO DELETE CERTAIN LANDS USED FOR THE FALLS LAKE STATE TRAIL FROM THE STATE PARKS SYSTEM AND REALLOCATE THOSE LANDS TO THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION; (2) directs the Div'n of Parks and Recreation of DENR to issue necessary permits notwithstanding 15A NCAC 12C.0305(b) and 15A NCAC 12C.0303; (3) deletes land described in bill from State Parks System and provides that state's leased interest in the land is reallocated to the Wildlife Resources Comm'n for its management; and (4) makes provisions concerning permits applicable to any application for a permit made on or before July 1, 2000.
