S 1018. MARRIAGE LICENSES AND STUDY-2. CONCERNING MARRIAGE LAWS. Amends GS 51-8 to provide that if applicant for marriage license does not have social security number and is ineligible to obtain one, the applicant may swear or affirm to the existence of that fact and register of deeds may issue license if all other requirements are met. Authorizes Legislative Research Commission to study GS Ch. 51 for possible changes that should be made. Comm'n may file interim report to 2000 session and final report to 2001 session.
