Replaces original bill with "AN ACT TO PROVIDE ECONOMIC PARITY FOR THE HAULING OF AGGREGATE PRODUCTS FROM LIMITED AREAS OF THE STATE." Adds GS 20-118(c)(14) to provide that GS 20-118(b) and (e) do not apply to vehicle hauling aggregates from a distribution yard or a State-permitted production site within a North Carolina county contiguous to the border to a destination in an adjacent state, that does not operate on an interstate highway or posted bridge, and that does not exceed stated weight limits. Effective July 1, 2000.
