AREA MENTAL HEALTH/COUNTY APPROP. *TO AMEND THE LAW TO ALLOW COUNTIES TO REDUCE COUNTY APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES FOR AREA MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES FOR FUTURE FISCAL YEARS.* Amends GS 122C-115(d) to limit section's prohibition on county's reducing appropriation to area authority because of availability of other funds to the fiscal year in which the funds were appropriated. S 1122. AREA MENTAL HEALTH/COUNTY APPROP. Intro. 4/15/99. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 122C-115(d) to provide that except as provided in that subsection, counties shall not reduce county appropriations and expenditures for current operations and ongoing programs and services of area authorities because of the availability of state-allocated funds, fees, capitation amounts, or fund balance to the area authority. Counties may reduce county appropriations by the amount previously appropriated by the county for one-time special needs of the area authority.
