**S 1127. STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE.** *TO CODIFY THE JOINT RESOLUTION DEDICATING PROPERTIES AS PART OF THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE, INCLUDING THE CODIFICATION OF NAME CHANGES OF CERTAIN LANDS PREVIOUSLY ACCEPTED INTO THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE; TO REMOVE CERTAIN LANDS FROM THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE; TO CODIFY THESE REMOVALS; AND TO DELETE CERTAIN LANDS FROM THE STATE PARKS SYSTEM.* As title indicates. Makes numerous technical and clarifying changes to elements of the state park system, including recognition of the new Gorges State Park, the Occoneechee Mountain State Natural Area, Lumber River State Park and Run Hill State Natural area as components of the State Nature and Historic Preserve.

**S 1127. STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE.** Intro. 04/15/99. Senate committee substitute makes the following change to 1st edition: deletes the provision proposed as GS 143-260.10(12) that would have prohibited the State of North Carolina from selling or exchanging the tract excluded from the Hanging Rock State Park except for the expansion of the park or to sell the land and use the proceeds for that purpose.

**S 1127. STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE.** Intro. 04/15/99. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Proposes technical correction to Sec. 5 of Art. XIV of the State Constitution to allow the dedication and acceptance of property into the State Nature and Historic Preserve by a bill, rather than resolution, of the General Assembly. Amendment to Constitution to be submitted to voters at the next election at which another amendment is submitted. Makes conforming changes to GS 143-260.8, subject to voter approval of constitutional amendment, and numerous other technical changes.
