S 1285. LITTER PREVENTION SPECIAL PLATE. Intro. 5/17/00. Senate committee substitute replaces 1st edition with a bill to "AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE LITTER PREVENTION SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES." As title indicates. Requires development of this license plate regardless of the number of applications for the plate requested. Creates Litter Prevention Account as a nonreverting special revenue account within the Highway Fund, under the control and direction of the Dep't of Transportation. Establishes additional fee for this plate at \$15, with \$5 distributed to the Special Registration Plate Account and \$10 distributed to the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account. Provides for quarterly transfer of funds in the latter Account derived from sale of this plate into the newly created Litter Prevention Account. Requires Dep't of Transportation, Dep't of Environment and Natural Resources, and Dep't of Public Instruction to work together to develop the plate's phrase and picture. Requires that Legislative Research Comm'n study issues related to prevention and removal of litter and make a final report of its recommendations to the 2001 General Assembly.
