Senate committee amendment makes the following changes to 1st edition: Rewrites sec. 50 of bill to direct the Dept. of the Sec'y of State to study the issue of fraudulent filings under GS 25, art. 9, that are intended to hinder, harass, delay, or otherwise interfere with public employees in the performance of their lawful duties. Directs the Dept. to report to the General Assembly by Jan. 1, 2001 with any recommendations, including the creation of civil or criminal sanctions or remedies related to these filings. Makes Parts I, II, and III of bill effective July 1, 2001. Makes numerous editorial changes.
