TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT UNDER THE MINING ACT OF 1971, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION. Amends GS 74-50 to require applicant for mining permit to notify chief administrative officer of each county and municipality in which affected land is located, owners of record of land adjoining tract, owners of record of land directly across a highway that has five lanes or less if tract of land that includes affected land is adjacent to highway, and to owners of record of land that lies directly across watercourse, railroad track, utility or public right-of-way that is adjacent to track of land affected if necessary to provide adequate notice of the application. (Now, must notify owners of record of land adjoining the proposed site and chief administrative officer of city or county in which located.) Effective September 1, 2000.

Clarifies that notice be sent to owners of land that lies within 1,000 feet of permit boundaries. Adds requirement that when dep't receives application for new permit or modification of permit that notice be sent with a request for comment to the listed state and federal agencies. Makes other technical changes and changes effective date to October 1, 2000 (was September 1, 2000).
