S 1365. EXPAND INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS. TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE NORTH CAROLINA BRIDGE AUTHORITY TO THE NORTH CAROLINA TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY, TO AUTHORIZE THE AUTHORITY TO CHARGE A TOLL ON A NORTH-SOUTH PRIMARILY RURAL INTERSTATE HIGHWAY, AND DIRECT USE OF INTERSTATE TOLL PROCEEDS TO EXPANSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THAT INTERSTATE AND FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES. Changes name of NC Bridge Authority as title indicates. Authorizes Authority to charge a toll to expand or maintain any major north-south interstate route in NC that does not pass through a municipality with a population greater than 250,000. Provides that any fees collected must be used for expanding or maintaining that interstate or for other transportation-related purposes. Provides that Authority has discretion to set tolls, subject to a statutory maximum of \$10.
