S 1365. EXPAND INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS. *TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE NORTH CAROLINA BRIDGE AUTHORITY TO THE NORTH CAROLINA TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY, TO AUTHORIZE THE AUTHORITY TO CHARGE A TOLL ON A NORTH-SOUTH PRIMARILY RURAL INTERSTATE HIGHWAY, AND DIRECT USE OF INTERSTATE TOLL PROCEEDS TO EXPANSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THAT INTERSTATE AND FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES.* Changes name of NC Bridge Authority as title indicates.

Authorizes Authority to charge a toll to expand or maintain any major north-south interstate route in NC that does not pass through a municipality with a population greater than 250,000. Provides that any fees collected must be used for expanding or maintaining that interstate or for other transportation-related purposes. Provides that Authority has discretion to set tolls, subject to a statutory maximum of \$10.
