S 198. ADULT CARE HOME LICENSURE (= H 198). *PERTAINING TO THE ISSUANCE OF A NEW ADULT CARE HOME LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT WHO WAS THE LICENSEE OR ADMINISTRATOR OF AN ADULT CARE HOME THE LICENSE OF WHICH HAD BEEN REVOKED OR DOWNGRADED TO PROVISIONAL STATUS OR AGAINST WHICH A TYPE A PENALTY HAD BEEN ASSESSED.* Amends GS 131D-2 to provide that a new license may not be issued for an adult care home within a specified time if the applicant is the administrator, licensee, or owner of an adult care home that was assessed a penalty for Type A or Type B violation or had its license summarily suspended or downgraded to provisional status as well as one that had its license revoked.

S 198. ADULT CARE HOME LICENSURE. Intro. 3/1/1999. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Makes proposed amendment to GS 131D-2(b) to make prohibition of adult care home licensing apply to owner, principal, or affiliate (previously, "administrator, licensee, or owner") of an adult care home that had experienced license revocation or certain other penalties. Amends GS 131E-124(c) to provide that person who has filed a complaint regarding a nursing facility must have access to information about complaint investigation involving specific resident if written authorization is obtained from the resident, legal representative, or responsible party. Facility must maintain designation of the responsible party in the resident's medical record. Revises effective date provision to provide that amendments to GS 131D-2(b) and GS 131E-124(c) apply to license application f filed on or after effective date of act.
