S 338. SCHOOL PERSONNEL/ CLASSROOM. TO GIVE CLASSROOM EXPERIENCE TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO ARE CERTIFIED TEACHERS BUT ARE NOT CLASSROOM TEACHERS. Adds new subsection (18a) to GS 115C-47 providing that school boards require professional public school employees who do not have daily instructional contact with students to serve as substitute teachers in the classroom for the equivalent of at least two days each school year. Requires State Board of Education to adopt a policy providing that time spent as a substitute teacher is an activity that earns renewal credit, and authorizes Board to determine how renewal credit will apply to such activity.

**S 338. SCHOOL PERSONNEL/CLASSROOM EXPER.** Intro. 3/15/99. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Requires local boards of education to adopt policy that requires professional employees to deliver instruction or to have other contact with students in classroom during day, which policy may require them to serve as substitute teachers, teach model lessons, assist teacher in classroom, or tutor individual students (was, required professional employees to serve at least 2 days per year as substitute teacher). Allows policy to give up to one renewal credit every 5 years for these activities instead of giving authority to State Board to determine amount of credit.
