S 39. MEDICAID RECOVERY STUDY. AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY STATE MEDICAID RECOVERY POLICY AND LAW. As title indicates. Study may include (1) federal requirements for Medicaid recovery efforts, whether current state efforts exceed federal requirements, and if not, the reasons therefore; (2) state recovery collections as percent of total Medicaid expenditures; (3) review of Medicaid recovery policy and laws enacted or being considered by other states; and (4) findings of study conducted by Division of Medical Assistance comparing state Medicaid recovery efforts, and policy options contained in study. Comm'n may make interim report to 2000 legislative session and must make final report to 2001 legislative session.
