S 560. COUNTRY HAM PRESERVATION ACT. TO CLARIFY THAT MARKETS THAT SELL UNCOOKED CURED COUNTRY HAM OR UNCOOKED CURED SALTED PORK THAT INVOLVES CERTAIN MINIMAL PREPARATION ARE EXEMPT FROM REGULATION UNDER CHAPTER 130A OF THE GENERAL STATUTES WHEN THAT MINIMAL PREPARATION IS THE ONLY ACTIVITY THAT WOULD SUBJECT THESE MARKETS TO SUCH REGULATION. As title indicates. Amends GS 130A-250 to exempt these meats when the preparation involves only slicing, weighing, or wrapping the ham or pork.
