S 563. CHARLOTTE SCHOOL ZONE SPEED CAMERAS. *TO AUTHORIZE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO USE PHOTOGRAPHIC SPEED-MEASURING SYSTEMS TO ESTABLISH SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT VIOLATIONS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE NORTH CAROLINA CRIMINAL JUSTICE EDUCATION AND TRAINING STANDARDS COMMISSION AND THE SECRETARY OF CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY TO APPROVE STANDARDS FOR THE PHOTOGRAPHIC SPEED-MEASURING SYSTEMS.* Authorizes Charlotte to use photographic speed-measuring systems to enforce GS 20-141.1, regulating speeding in school zones. Provides that any violation of such section detected by a photographic speed-measuring system is not a infraction or misdemeanor but is a civil violation.
