S 58. EXPAND INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS. TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE NORTH CAROLINA BRIDGE AUTHORITY TO THE NORTH CAROLINA TOLL ROAD AND BRIDGE AUTHORITY, TO AUTHORIZE THE AUTHORITY TO CHARGE A TOLL ON A NORTH-SOUTH PRIMARILY RURAL INTERSTATE HIGHWAY, AND DIRECT USE OF INTERSTATE TOLL PROCEEDS TO EXPANSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THAT INTERSTATE AND FOR OTHER TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES. Amends Art. 6F of GS Ch. 136 as title indicates. Provides that cited Authority may charge toll to expand or maintain any major north-south interstate route in NC that does not pass through municipality with population greater than 250,000, according to latest decennial census. Tolls for interstate highways shall be in discretion of Authority, but shall not exceed \$10.
