S 601. DOC PRISONERS' UNIFORMS. *TO PROVIDE THAT THE SECRETARY OF CORRECTION HAS SOLE AUTHORITY TO DESIGNATE THE UNIFORMS WORN BY INMATES CONFINED IN THE DIVISION OF PRISONS.* As title indicates. Provides that, unless the Sec'y determines otherwise, state inmates housed in local confinement facilities must wear uniforms consistent with those worn in the Div'n of Prisons. Effective when act becomes law.
