S 614. IMMUNIZATION LAW CHANGES. *TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE IMMUNIZATION LAWS PERTAINING TO ADMINISTRATION AND REPORTING OF IMMUNIZATIONS, CERTIFICATES OF IMMUNIZATIONS RECEIVED IN OTHER STATES, SUBMISSION OF IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATES TO CHILD CARE FACILITIES AND PRESCHOOL AUTHORITIES, AND TO MAKE OTHER TECHNICAL CHANGES TO THE IMMUNIZATION STATUTES.* Amends GS 130A-153 to provide that local health departments are to administer required *and state-supplied* immunizations at no charge, adding italicized language; and to permit Department of Health and Human Services to require additional information in monthly immunization reports filed by local health departments. Adds new GS 130A-154(b), setting out information that must be included in certificate or record of immunization administered in other state, when person presents such certificate to child care facility, school, or college or university. Amends GS 130A-155 to prohibit attending a preschool educational program not operated by a public school without receiving immunizations required by GS 130A-152.
