S 703. HAMPSTEAD INCORPORATION. *TO INCORPORATE THE TOWN OF HAMPSTEAD SUBJECT TO A REFERENDUM.* New town is located in Pender County. Town will have a governing board of five members (one of whom is to be selected mayor by the governing board), elected at-large in nonpartisan elections to two-year terms. Town will operate on the council-manager plan. Referendum to approve incorporation will be held between 60 and 120 days after bill becomes law. Names individuals to sit on initial governing board and to serve until successors are elected in November 1999
