TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF CERTAIN EXCAVATION AND GRADING ACTIVITIES UNDER THE SEDIMENTATION POLLUTION CONTROL ACT OF 1973 INSTEAD OF THE MINING ACT OF 1971. Amends GS 74-49(7) to exclude from definition of mining any excavation or grading where: (1) work is done to provide soil or other unconsolidated material for single construction project for which erosion control plan has been approved; (2) affected land is not more than five acres; (3) work is completed in one year; (4) work does not involve blasting, removal of material from streams, disposal of off-site waste on the affected land, or disposal of groundwater beyond the affected area; (5) work is not in violation of any local ordinance; and (6) erosion control plan for the excavation and grading has been approved. Effective Oct. 1, 1999.
