S 785. REGULATION OF LP GAS. TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE INSPECTION AND REGULATION OF LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GASES. Amends GS 119-58 to provide that liquefied petroleum gas burning appliances sold in NC must be approved by the American Gas Association, the Underwriters Laboratory, Inc. and the Building Code Council (now, by the Comm'r of Agriculture), and to delete provisions making it unlawful to install any unvented space heating appliance in a manufactured home or in a sleeping room that has an input of over 30 BTU per cubic feet of enclosure. Applies to liquefied petroleum gas burning appliances installed on or after date of enactment.

S 785. REGULATION OF LP GAS. Intro. 4/7/99. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Adds provision directing the Legislative Research Comm'n to study advisability of allowing use of unvented gas burning heating appliances in manufactured and modular homes. Study to include consultation with Building Code Council and Dep'ts of Insurance and Health and Human Services. Authorizes interim report in 2000, with final report in 2001.
