S 791. TEN YEAR DRIVERS LICENSE. TO CHANGE THE GENERAL DRIVERS LICENSE RENEWAL CYCLE FROM FIVE TO TEN YEARS. Amends GS 20-7(f) to provide that drivers license issued to person at least 16 but less than 18 expires on person's 20th birthday; license issued to person between the ages of 18 and 60 expires 10 years after date of issuance; license issued to person between 60 and 80 years of age expires the earlier of 5 years after issued or the person's 80th birthday; and a license issued to a person age 80 or over expires 3 years from issuance. Requires person holding ten-year license who has three reportable accidents or who is convicted of three moving violations within a twelve month period to attend a drivers license consultation. Amends GS 20-37.7 to provide that special identification card expires 5 years after issued. Effective July 1, 2000.
