S 812. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES. *TO REQUIRE THAT A FOOD OR RETAIL BUSINESS THAT HOLDS AN ABC PERMIT AND IS LOCATED IN AN URBAN REDEVELOPMENT AREA SHALL NOT HAVE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES IN EXCESS OF FIFTY PERCENT OF THE BUSINESS'S TOTAL ANNUAL SALES.* Amends GS 18B by adding a new GS 18B-309 as title indicates. Allows city to request that ABC Comm'n investigate business to see if it is violation of section. Defines food business, retail business and urban redevelopment area for purposes of act. Allows Comm'n to revoke permit of permittee in violation of act.

S 812. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES. Intro. 4/12/99. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Makes act applicable to eating establishments as defined in GS 18B-1000(2). Provides that a city may request an investigation of a particular business only once each calendar year, and the comm'n may do an investigation only on request of a city council. Businesses covered by the act shall maintain full and accurate monthly records of their finances and shall separately show sales of alcoholic beverages and other items.
