SUBSTANCE SCHEDULES. *TO UPDATE THE NORTH CAROLINA CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT TO ACCURATELY REFLECT THE CURRENT SCHEDULING OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES, AS SCHEDULED BY THE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION.* Amends GS 90-89(3) to add 4-Bromo-2, 5-Dimethoxyphenethylamine; GS 90-90(1) to delete thebaine derived butorphanol, and GS 90-92(a)(3) to add Cathine, Fencamfamin, Fenproporex, Mefenorex, Sibutramine, and -92(a)(4) to add Butorphanol.

Adds new subsection (4b) to GS 90-95(h) to prohibit trafficking in methylenedioxyamphetamine (MDA) or methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA) and amends title accordingly. New provision becomes effective Dec. 1, 1999 and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
