Amends GS 153A-353 to specify that the county may contract with the employer of an individual who holds a certificate and makes corresponding change in GS 160A-413 applicable to municipalities. Adds new category to conflict of interest provisions in GS 153A-355 and GS 160A-415 requiring a finding of conflict of interest where the inspector is "closely related" to the owner, developer, contractor, or project manager of the project to be inspected. Makes other conforming changes.
