H 1041. BALLOT INSTRUCTIONS IN SPANISH. TO REQUIRE THAT BALLOT INSTRUCTIONS BE PRINTED IN SPANISH AS WELL AS ENGLISH. Amends GS 163-140.2 as title indicates.

Requires the State Board of Education to prepare a Spanish translation of ballot instructions for county boards of elections. Effective Jan. 1, 2002.

Provides that if S 17 of 2001 Session of General Assembly is enacted, then GS 163-140.2 is recodified as GS 163-165.5A. Act effective with respect to all primaries, elections, and referenda held on or after Aug. 1, 2001, and sunsets bill on Jan. 1, 2012.
