H 1047. VOTER SAFETY. TO PROVIDE PROTECTION FOR REGISTERED VOTERS TO ADDRESS SAFETY MEASURES. Creates GS 163-82.10 to provide that if a voter submits a signed statement that the voter has good reason to believe the physical safety of the voter or the voter's family member would be jeopardized by disclosure of the voter's address, the registrar shall exclude that voter's address from public inspection and the address shall not be a public record. Allows for inspection of the address by a law enforcement agency or by court order. **Intro. by Alexander.**
