Adds provision repealing Sec. 19 of SL 2000-19 (directing the Commission on Health Services to adopt a rule concerning disposal of certain dry cleaning solvents) and deletes provision amending Sec. 11 of SL 1993-471 (as amended) (concerning the white goods disposal tax).
