H 1160. HEALTH INS./UNIFORM PROVIDER CREDENTIALING. TO PROVIDE FOR UNIFORM PROVIDER CREDENTIALING BY HEALTH INSURANCE PLANS. Creates GS 58-3-230 to require insurers providing health benefit plans to maintain a process to verify the qualifications of health care practitioners. Requires Comm'r of Insurance to adopt a uniform provider credentialing application form to provide credentialing entities with information necessary to verify qualifications of an applicant; insurers may only require submission of information on the uniform form. Effective Oct. 1, 2001.

H 1160. HEALTH INS./UNIFORM PROVIDER CREDENTIALING. Intro. 3/12/01. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 58-65-2 and 58-67-171 to add statutory cross-reference GS 58-3-230 created by this act.

H 1160. HEALTH INS./UNIFORM PROVIDER CREDENTIALING. Intro. 4/12/01. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Deletes sec. 2 (amending GS 58-65-2) and sec. 3 (amending GS 58-67-171) from prior edition. Modifies sec. 1 of prior edition by (1) providing that GS 58-3-230(a) applies to all insurer that credential providers for its networks, (2) including a provision that the Commissioner may update the uniform credentialing application form as necessary, and (3) making technical changes.
