H 1174. INCREASE PENALTY/DRUG SALES @ PARKS. TO INCREASE THE CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR THE SALE OF DRUGS IN PUBLIC PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS. Adds new GS 90-95(e)(10), making it a Class E felony for any person 21 years of age or older to commit an offense under GS 90-95(a)(1) (manufacture, sale, delivery, or possession of controlled substance) on property that is a playground in a public park or within 300 feet of the boundary of real property that is a playground in a public park, but excludes transfer of less than 5 grams of marijuana for no remuneration. Effective Dec. 1, 2001, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
