Changes title to read *TO REDUCE THE THRESHOLD FOR A STATEWIDE SECOND PRIMARY TO TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT.* Retains current statutory provisions for second primaries (necessary if no candidate receives 40% of votes), but provides that in statewide primaries, a second primary is necessary only if no candidate receives 25% of votes. Makes act effective Jan. 1, 2002.
