H 1185. NO-EXCUSE ABSENTEE DEADLINE. TO ADJUST THE PERIOD FOR NO-EXCUSE ONE-STOP ABSENTEE VOTING BY ALLOWING MORE TIME AFTER THE BOOKS CLOSE TO BEGIN THE PROCESS, BUT TO EXTEND IT TO INCLUDE THE SATURDAY BEFORE THE ELECTION. Rewrites GS 163-227.2(b) to provide that the period during which a person may apply for an absentee ballot at the office of a county board of elections is not earlier than the first business day after the 22nd (was 25th) day before an election and not later than 5:00 p.m. on the Saturday before the election. Rewrites GS 163-227.2(f) to add requirement that office of a county board of elections be open on the Saturday before the election. Applies with respect to elections held on or after Jan. 1, 2002.
