Amends GS 143-64.15(c) to change threshold for required preparation of life-cycle cost analysis from 40,000 to 20,000 square feet. Revises proposed GS 143-64.15A to require submission of analysis prior to advertising for bids for construction and allows Dep't of Administration to require additional agency analysis.

H 1272. ENERGY CONSERVATION/PILOT PROGRAM. Intro. 4/12/01. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Adds to proposed GS 143-64.15A (Certification of life-cycle cost analysis) a requirement that Department of Administration require all construction or renovation conducted by state agency that uses life-cycle cost analysis to comply with the terms of any certification of the analysis issued by the Dep't. Redefines type of facility to be built in Triangle J Council of Government pilot program as "high performing facility", instead of "sustainably designed facility" and specifies that use of water conservation measures is one criterion that such facility must meet.
