H 144. SCHOOL CLOSED/INCLEMENT WEATHER/FLEX. TO PROVIDE ADMINISTRATIVE FLEXIBILITY TO SCHOOLS THAT ARE CLOSED DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER. Amends GS 115C-84.2 (school calendar) to provide that a school district that loses more than 12 days due to inclement weather may elect to operate for that year with a calendar that includes a minimum of 180 days, or a minimum of 1,000 hours of instructional time, or both. District is not required to have both a minimum of 180 days and a minimum of 1,000 instructional hours. Amends GS 115C-174.129(b) to require that state policies about statewide testing must permit late testing in local school units that have lost a significant amount of instructional time due to inclement weather. Effective July 1, 2001.
