Adds new GS 130A-149 requiring DHHS to establish and administer program for registration of biological agents, defined as microorganisms, viruses, infectious substances, and other products capable of causing death, disease, deterioriation of food, and other serious harms to public health or safety. Requires Comm'n on Health Services to adopt rules for implementing registry program. Provides that information in registry is confidential and not a public record; allows release only in designated instances, such as in connection with communicable disease investigation. Requires DHHS to impose civil penalty of \$1,000 per day for violation. Effective Jan. 1, 2002. Intro. by Culpepper.
